Non-Profit Status

Election of Directors

The first meeting of the Friends of Dinsmore Elementary occurred on February 14, 2019. The directors elected at the first meeting and the special meeting of April 4, 2019 are now set to begin serving their first full fiscal year.

Goals for 2019-2020 School Year

All the effort by Friends to this date has been in preparation for the 2019-2020 school year. The *primary* goals for the 2019-2020 school year are as follows:

- Mystery Science subscription and supplies
 - Funding has been obtained for the 2019-2020 school year
- K to 2 Tutoring with the Boselli Foundation partnership
 - Scheduled to be launched in the Fall with recruiting commencing in July
 - Grant funding would help attract more volunteers and improve the effectiveness of the tutoring
- SignUpGenius subscription and use by the teachers and staff
 - Funding has been obtained for the 2019-2020 school year
- Science Experts
 - Requires grant funding
- Create a Science Lab
 - Requires grant funding
- HMH Google/Virtual Field Trips
 - Requires grant funding

However, the grant already written can't be submitted until the IRS approves our exempt status.
